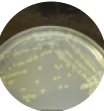
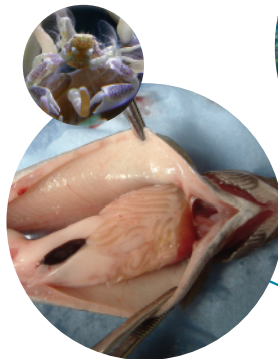
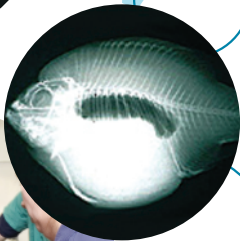
The Growing Need for an International Resource
